



HAFNIA SHIP RECYCLING POLICY

Hafnia Pools Pte Ltd and its subsidiary owning companies are committed to conducting all its's business in an ethical, legal and socially responsible manner to prevent, reduce and minimize accidents, injuries and other adverse effects on human health and the environment. This commitment extends to ship recycling with an ultimate objective to dispose ships responsibly, safe and environmentally friendly.

Recycling of any Hafnia vessel shall therefore be performed at a reputable and certified recycling facility, having the ability to meet the applicable regulations. The selected recycling and demolition facility must hold a valid Class issued Statement of Compliance with the Hong Kong Convention 2009, or EU Regulation 1257/2013.

The recycling may not cause pollution of the surrounding waters, land and atmosphere. The recycling must be in a manner in which hazardous materials onboard are identified, demarcated and carefully removed prior to, or during the recycling process and disposed of in a way which would render them harmless, and the recycling shall be performed in a manner wherein the safety, health and dignity of the human workforce involved in the process remain paramount, and work practices and conditions of their employment ensure this.
